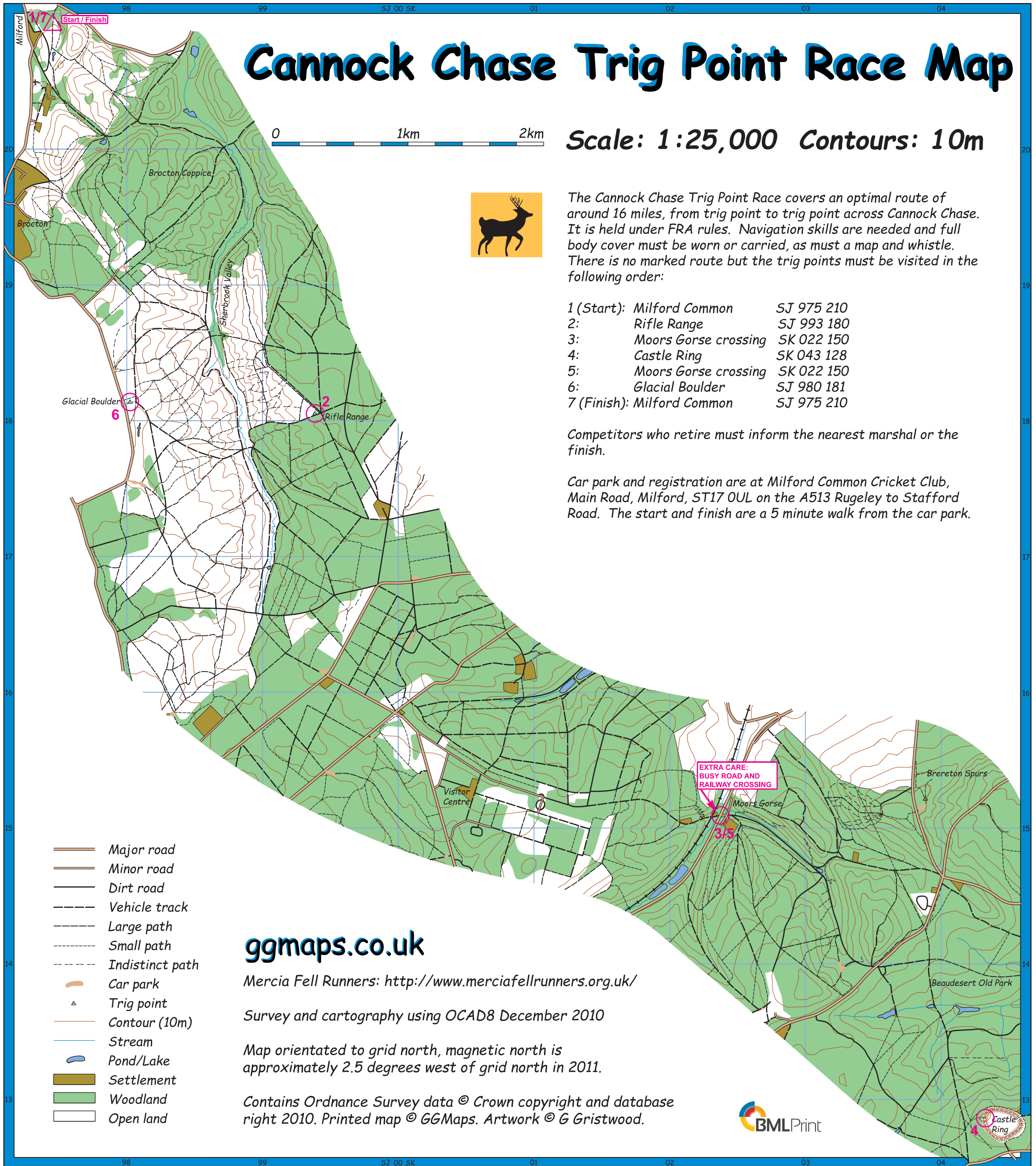


The Cannock Chase Trig Point Race covers an optimal route of around 16 miles, from trig point to trig point across Cannock Chase. It is held under FRA rules. Navigation skills are needed and full body cover must be worn or carried, as must a map and whistle. There is no marked route but the trig points must be visited in the following order:

Competitors who retire must inform the nearest marshal or the finish.

Car park and registration are at Milford Common Cricket Club, Main Road, Milford, ST17 0UL on the A513 Rugeley to Stafford Road. The start and finish are a 5 minute walk from the car park.
